Welcome to the 8th grade Washington, D.C. trip!

The dates of this year's trip are May 16 - May 20, 2022. We will leave OLMS around 6 a.m. on Monday, May 16 and return about 9 p.m. on Friday, May 20. It is a busy week of touring our nation's capital! Students will have interesting educational experiences and make life-long memories. Do **NOT** pay non-refundable deposit or register with Prodigy until **Friday, January 14th, 2022**.

Every 8th grade student has the opportunity to participate in this voluntary trip. However, in order to be successful on this trip, students need to demonstrate an increased level of maturity and personal responsibility. To that end, it is expected that throughout the school year students wishing to participate adhere to the Student Code of Conduct.

Below is a brief overview of important dates for the trip:

- January 14—Registration and deposit made to Prodigy Student Travel; Rules and Guidelines and Health forms returned to OLMS
- February—All fundraising totals are posted in the students' accounts (all funds raised will be distributed evenly between all students attending the trip)
- February—Medication forms sent home; due in March
- April 15—Every student must be paid in full (all payments are made directly to Prodigy)
- May 15—Luggage check-in (4:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m.)
- May 18—Students arrive at OLMS 5:30 a.m., depart 6:00 a.m. for D.C.
- May 16-20—Trip to Washington, D.C.
- May 20—Arrive back at OLMS approximately 9:00 p.m.
